## **Bigger fuller and some orange ones too**

The "not orange" and the "orange" descriptors below need some explanation. For those that know about these wines, this note is irrelevant, but for the other 99.5% it's worth a little read. Orange is a place in NSW and these wines have nothing to do with that at all. The wines below that are orange, are white wines that have spent a long time "on skins", and the colour over time has turned orange. A quasi controlled oxidation if you will. It's a big thing at the moment, the wine world is divided and they are at the very pointy end of what's cool. It's hard to describe them, but essentially they are rich, full bodied, textural wines, not too dissimilar to red wine. Both are ridiculously hard to get and will polarize any audience. The Gravner is arguably the epitome of this style of wine, the Serragghia is the most challenging wine I have ever had.
